

California	<p>Senior Agents (agents licensed 4 years or longer): Long-Term Care— 8 hours CTQ course every two years. *Partnership — 8 hours every 2 years.</p>
	<p>Junior Agents (agents licensed fewer than 4 years): Long-Term Care — 8 hours year 1, 2, 3, and 4. *Partnership — 8 hours year 1; 4 hours year 2, 3, 4.</p>
Connecticut	<p>Long-Term Care — 7 hours TAKEN ONE TIME ONLY.</p>
Colorado	<p>2 Hours LTC — TAKEN ONE TIME ONLY.</p>
Delaware	<p>Medical supplement License required to sell Long-Term Care Insurance. Renew every two years.</p>
Indiana	<p>Long-Term Care — 8 hours first-year selling Long-Term Care Insurance: 5 hours every two years renewal period thereafter. (Note: IN is not a reciprocal state for LTC CE units! Only applies to general CE units). Required for resident agents only. *Partnership — Additional 7 hour course required to sell Indiana Partnership policies.</p>
Illinois	<p>6 hours LTC (resident and non-resident agents) - TAKEN ONE TIME ONLY.</p>
Maryland	<p>2 Hours of LTC by June 30th of every odd numbered calendar year.</p>
New York Partnership	<p>8 Hour Certification course required.</p>
North Carolina	<p>Medical Supplement License required to sell LTC (includes 10 hours pre-licensing taken in NC). No correspondence course available.</p>
Washington	<p>6 Hours of LTC every 2-year renewal period.</p>
